A BILL

To prohibit taxpayer funds from being used to build a wall between Mexico and the United States, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protect American Tax-
- 5 payers and Secure Border Act".

1 SEC. 2. PROHIBITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO

- 2 BORDER SECURITY.
- 3 (a) In General.—No taxpayer funds may be obli-
- 4 gated or expended to build a wall or barrier intended to
- 5 impede travel between Mexico and the United States.
- 6 (b) Foreign Payment Required.—Any wall or
- 7 barrier described in subsection (a) that is proposed to be
- 8 built shall be paid for using funds provided by the Govern-
- 9 ment of Mexico.
- 10 (c) Securing the Southern Border.—The Sec-
- 11 retary of Homeland Security shall take such actions as
- 12 may be necessary to secure the southern border by making
- 13 maximum effective utilization of technology and improved
- 14 training of U.S. Custom and Border Protection agents
- 15 and officers.
- 16 (d) Increase in Immigration Judges.—The Attor-
- 17 ney General may appoint 100 additional immigration
- 18 judges in addition to immigration judges currently serving
- 19 as of the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 20 (e) Humanitarian Assistance.—The Secretary of
- 21 Homeland Security shall take such actions as may be nec-
- 22 essary to ensure that humanitarian assistance is provided
- 23 to immigrants, refugees, and other displaced persons who
- 24 are in need of medical assistance and aid to sustain health
- 25 and life.
