spherical convex lenses, uniform in each meridian, which are encased in eyeglass frames and intended to ameliorate the symptoms of presbyopia. The lenses in over-the-counter spectacles may not have a minus power (-) and may not exceed plus three and one-half diopters (+3.50).

- (b) The sale of over-the-counter spectacles which do not conform to the definition in subsection (a) is unlawful.
- (c) A violation of this act may be enforced by the Board of Optometry, a district attorney, or the Attorney General.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
