3	WHEREAS, in 1805, United States Marine Corps Lieutenant Presley Neville
4	O'Bannon was selected by President Thomas Jefferson to free 180 Americans held
5	captive for ransom in Tripoli by the Barbary Pirates; and
6	WHEREAS, Lieutenant O'Bannon led seven Marines, a midshipman, and a motley
7	rabble of more than 1,000 mercenaries across 600 miles of the Sahara desert to the
8	Tripolitan city of Derne where the battle ensued; and
9	WHEREAS, despite being greatly outnumbered, Lieutenant O'Bannon and his
10	Marines fought so bravely that they became legendary in song among our enemies; and
11	WHEREAS, Lieutenant O'Bannon personally hauled down the enemy flag and
12	hoisted the Stars and Stripes for the first time in battle on foreign soil; and
13	WHEREAS, following his military service, Lieutenant O'Bannon moved to
14	Kentucky and built his home. He was elected to the Kentucky General Assembly where
15	he represented Logan County with great distinction from 1812 until 1820 in the House of
16	Representatives and the Senate; and
17	WHEREAS, Lieutenant O'Bannon was a Marine and patriot of the highest caliber
18	who demonstrated exceptional leadership, bravery, skill, and determination under severe
19	conditions to ensure freedom, peace, and America's great national economic and military
20	status in the world; and
21	WHEREAS, the Logan County home Lieutenant O'Bannon purchased still stands in
22	Russellville, Kentucky, and is on the National and Kentucky Registry of Historic Places;

24	WHEREAS, the O'Bannon House Preservation Foundation was established to
25	preserve the hero's home in order to provide a venue to promote patriotism and our
26	history;
