- 16 (d) (1) The Administration may not register as a cannabis agent an individual who does not meet the criteria established under subsection (c) of this section.
- 18 (2) The Administration may disqualify an individual from registering as a 19 cannabis agent if the individual has been convicted of or pleaded nolo contendere to a crime 20 involving moral turpitude, whether or not any appeal or other proceeding is pending to 21 have the conviction or plea set aside.
- 22 (e) The Administration may not deny a cannabis agent registration based on any cannabis—related offenses occurring before July 1, 2023.
- 24 (f) A cannabis licensee shall require each registered cannabis agent to complete 25 an annual responsible vendor training program authorized under this title.
- 26 (g) A registration of a cannabis agent issued by the Natalie M. LaPrade Medical Cannabis Commission on or before July 1, 2023, shall:
- 28 (1) be valid under this title; and
- 29 (2) authorize the cannabis agent to be employed by or volunteer with a 30 licensed cannabis business.

1 In this title the following words have the meanings indicated. (a) 2 "Security guard" means an individual who, regardless of whether the 3 individual is described as a security guard, watchman, or private patrolman or by other title: 4 (1) is an employee of a security guard agency; and 5 (i) 6 provides security guard services to another person on behalf of (ii) 7 the security guard agency; or is an employee of a security guard employer; and 8 (2) (i) 9 provides security guard services to the security guard employer. (ii) "Security guard agency" means a person who conducts a business that 10 (1)(1)11 provides security guard services. "Security guard agency" does not include: 12 (2)a person that is primarily engaged in the business of owning, 13 (i) maintaining, or otherwise managing property; or 14 15 (ii) a security guard employer. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16
