A BILL

To designate a National Memorial to Fallen Educators at the National Teachers Hall of Fame in Emporia, Kansas.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Memorial to
- 5 Fallen Educators Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION.
- 7 (a) In General.—The memorial to fallen educators
- 8 located at the National Teachers Hall of Fame in Emporia,
- 9 Kansas, is designated as the "National Memorial to Fallen
- 10 Educators".
- 11 (b) Effect of Designation.—The national memo-
- 12 rial designated by this section is not a unit of the National
- 13 Park System and the designation of the National Memorial
- 14 to Fallen Educators shall not require or permit Federal
- 15 funds to be expended for any purpose related to that na-
- 16 tional memorial.
