Chapter 552

(Senate Bill 38)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages - Board of License Commissioners - Qualifications

FOR the purpose of requiring that each member of the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore County be a resident and voter of Baltimore County; and generally relating to the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore County.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

Article – Alcoholic Beverages Section 13–101(a) and (b) and 13–102 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2020 Supplement)

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Alcoholic Beverages Section 13–202 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2020 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Alcoholic Beverages

13–101.

- (a) In this title:
- (1) the definitions in $\S 1-101$ of this article apply without exception or variation; and
 - (2) the following words have the meanings indicated.
 - (b) "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore County.

13-102.

This title applies only in Baltimore County.

13 - 202.

- (a) The County Executive shall appoint three members to the Board.
- (b) EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL BE A RESIDENT AND VOTER OF THE COUNTY.
 - **(C)** (1) The term of a member is 2 years.
- (2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Board on July 1, 2016.
- [(c)] **(D)** The County Executive may remove a member for misconduct in office, incompetence, or willful neglect of duty.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
