## Battery Storage and Solar Arrays Safety Training Grant Program and Fund

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Battery Storage and Solar Arrays Safety Training 4 Grant Program in the Maryland Energy Administration to provide grants to local 5 governments to train local fire departments on certain safety aspects associated with 6 lithium-ion battery storage systems installed with solar arrays; requiring the 7 Administration, in consultation with certain entities, to establish certain training 8 and emergency response standards; establishing the Battery Storage and Solar 9 Arrays Safety Training Grant Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; and generally 10 relating to lithium—ion battery storage systems and solar arrays.
