Mr. Schumer submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

To provide for related procedures concerning the article of impeachment against Donald John Trump, President of the United States.

1 Resolved, That—

2 (1) pursuant to rules III and IV of the Rules 3 and Procedures and Practice When sitting on Im-4 peachment Trials, on Tuesday, February 9, 2021, 5 the Senate shall proceed to the consideration of the 6 article of impeachment and that the Secretary of the 7 Senate shall notify the House of Representatives of 8 the time and place fixed for the Senate to proceed 9 upon the impeachment of Donald John Trump in 10 the Senate Chamber;

1	(2) under rule VIII of the Procedure and
2	Guidelines for Impeachment Trials in the United
3	States Senate—
4	(A) the summons shall be issued in the
5	usual form to Donald John Trump, provided
6	that he may have until 12:00 pm on Tuesday,
7	February 2, 2021, to file his answer with the
8	Secretary of the Senate;
9	(B) the House of Representatives may
10	have until 12:00 pm on Monday, February 8,
11	2021, to file its replication with the Secretary
12	of the Senate;
13	(C) if the House of Representatives wishes
14	to file a trial brief, it shall be filed by 10:00 am
15	on Tuesday, February 2, 2021;
16	(D) if Donald John Trump wishes to file
17	a trial brief, it shall be filed by 10:00 am on
18	Monday, February 8, 2021; and
19	(E) the House of Representatives may file
20	a rebuttal brief no later than 10:00 am on
21	Tuesday, February 9, 2021;
22	(3) the Senate directs the parties, in addition to
23	addressing the charge of incitement of insurrection
24	in the Article of Impeachment approved by the
25	House on January 13, 2021, to address in their trial

briefs whether Donald John Trump is subject to the jurisdiction of a court of impeachment for acts committed as President of the United States, notwithstanding the expiration of his term in said office; and

(4) the Senate directs the parties to be prepared to address at the commencement of the trial on February 9, 2021, whether Donald John Trump is subject to the jurisdiction of a court of impeachment for acts committed as President of the United States, notwithstanding the expiration of his term in said office.
