- 20 (b) State personnel, as defined in § 12–101 of the State Government Article, are
- 21 immune from suit in courts of the State and from liability in tort for a tortious act or
- 22 omission that is within the scope of the public duties of the State personnel and is made
- 23 without malice or gross negligence, and for which the State or its units have waived
- 24 immunity under Title 12, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article, even if the damages
