RESOLUTION

Prohibiting the imposition of vaccination, testing, and masking requirements relating to COVID-19 for Senate Pages.

1 Resolved, SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON COVID-19 VACCINATION, 3 TESTING, AND MASKING REQUIREMENTS FOR 4 SENATE PAGES. 5 A Senate Page or applicant to be a Senate Page may not be required to— 7 (1) show proof of COVID-19 vaccination sta-8 tus; (2) receive a vaccination for COVID-19; 9

- 1 (3) undergo testing for COVID-19 without 2 cause; or
- 3 (4) wear a mask.
