BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education Section 7-423.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 7-423.1.

(b) [Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an] AN Executive Branch agency may NOT ban or regulate the sale of coffee in conjunction with a career exploration and development activity CREATED FOR OR ORGANIZED BY STUDENTS WITH INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAMS in a public high school.
[(c) An Executive Branch agency may not ban or regulate the sale of coffee in conjunction with a career exploration and development activity in a public high school that sold coffee on or before June 30, 2018.]
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
