## Human Services - Two Generation Family Economic Security Commission

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Two Generation Family Economic Security 4 Commission in the Department of Human Services; providing for the composition, 5 chair, and staffing of the Commission; prohibiting a member of the Commission from 6 receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain 7 expenses; requiring the Commission to study, evaluate, and coordinate services and 8 programs to address multigenerational poverty; authorizing the Commission to use 9 certain funding to implement certain programs and to partner with local jurisdictions and local action agencies to implement the programs; requiring the 10 11 Commission to submit an annual report of its studies and recommendations to the 12 Governor and the General Assembly; requiring units of executive agencies to 13 cooperate with the Commission; requiring the Governor to provide funding for the 14 Commission in the Department's annual budget; specifying the terms of certain 15 initial members of the Commission; defining a certain term; and generally relating 16 to the Two Generation Family Economic Security Commission.

- EACH EXECUTIVE UNIT OF THE STATE SHALL COOPERATE FULLY WITH THE COMMISSION IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE COMMISSION'S DUTIES.

- THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE THE COMMISSION IN THE DEPARTMENT'S ANNUAL BUDGET.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Two Generation Family Economic Security Commission appointed under § 2–603(a)(11) through (13) of the Human Services Article shall expire as follows:
- 9 (1) one member in 2022;
- 10 (2) two members in 2023; and
- 11 (3) two members in 2024.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2020.
