BY adding to Article – State Government Section 9-2016 Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Government 9-2016. (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE CARBON CAPTURE OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM.
