- 16 (c) (1) A person may not fish with any net whose size of stretched mesh, allowing a reasonable tolerance for shrinkage, is less than the following: pound net, 1 1/2 inches; haul seine, 1 1/2 inches; gill net, 2 1/2 inches; fyke or hoop net, 1 1/2 inches.
- 19 (2) Any hedging or lead attached to a fish trap, fyke net, or pound net shall 20 be constructed of materials which have meshes having a twine size of #12 or larger.
- 21 (3) In the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, a person may not set or fish 22 any gill net [whose size of stretched mesh is more than 6 inches] **THAT HAS:**
