11	<u>(2)</u>	Unless otherwise specifically indicated or provided, the sections of this subtitle
12		shall not apply to or affect any of the following:
13		(a) Policies, plans, certificates, or contracts covering only accident, credit,
14		dental, vision, or specified disease, illness, or condition;
15		(b) Disability income insurance;
16		(c) Paid family leave insurance;
17		(d) Long-term care insurance;
18		(e) Short-term nursing home insurance;
19		(f) Medicare supplement insurance;
20		(g) Hospital indemnity or other fixed indemnity insurance;
21		(h) Coverage provided under a limited health service benefit plan, as defined in
22		KRS 304.17C-010, including a limited health service contract, as defined in
23		KRS 304.38A-010;
24		(i) Coverage under which benefits for medical expenses are:
25		1. Contained in, or included as a rider, amendment, or supplemental
26		policy provision to, any liability insurance policy or contract or

1	2. Supplemental to other insurance or equivalent self-insurance benefits,
2	including the following:
3	a. Automobile medical-payment insurance; and
4	b. Life insurance or endowment or annuity contracts;
5	(j) Medical expense reimbursement coverage that is:
6	1. Specifically designed to supplement, or fill gaps in, primary health
7	insurance coverage; and
8	2. Provided under a policy, plan, certificate, or contract that is separate
9	from the primary health insurance coverage;
10	(k) Coverage or benefits provided under:
11	1. KRS Chapter 205 or 342; or
12	2. Any other statutory-based public assistance or compensation program;
13	(1) Coverage or benefits for on-site medical clinics;
14	(m) Coverage or benefits provided under a health flexible spending
15	arrangement; or
16	(n) Other types of similar or limited insurance, coverage, or benefits, to the
17	extent specified by the commissioner in an administrative regulation
18	promulgated in accordance with KRS Chapter 13A.
