A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for coverage under the Medicare program of certain DNA Specimen Provenance Assay clinical diagnostic laboratory tests.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Prostate Cancer Mis-
5	diagnosis Elimination Act of 2017".
6	SEC. 2. COVERAGE OF CERTAIN DNA SPECIMEN PROVE-
7	NANCE ASSAY CLINICAL DIAGNOSTIC LAB-
8	ORATORY TESTS UNDER MEDICARE.
9	(a) Coverage.—Section 1862(a)(1) of the Social Se-
10	curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(a)(1)) is amended—
11	(1) in subparagraph (O), by striking "and" at
12	$the\ end;$
13	(2) in subparagraph (P), by striking the semi-
14	colon at the end and inserting ", and"; and
15	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
16	paragraph:
17	"(Q) in the case of a DNA Specimen Provenance
18	Assay clinical diagnostic laboratory test (DSPA test)
19	furnished on or after the date specified in section
20	1834A(j)(4), unless the DSPA test is furnished to an
21	individual enrolled under part B who has had a pros-
22	tate cancer biopsy the results of which are positive,
23	the DSPA test is furnished with respect to such bi-
24	opsy, and the DSPA test is ordered by the physician

1	who furnished the prostate cancer biopsy that ob-
2	tained the specimen tested;".
3	(b) Temporary Payment Amount for Certain
4	Tests Furnished Before 2028 and Related Require-
5	MENTS.—Section 1834A of the Social Security Act (42
6	U.S.C. 1395m-1) is amended—
7	(1) in subsection (b)(1)(A), by striking "and (d)"
8	and inserting ", (d), and (j)"; and
9	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
10	section:
11	"(j) DNA Specimen Provenance Assay Clinical
12	Diagnostic Laboratory Tests.—
13	"(1) Temporary payment amount for cer-
14	tain tests furnished before 2028.—With respect
15	to a DNA Specimen Provenance Assay clinical diag-
16	nostic laboratory test furnished on or after the date
17	specified in paragraph (4) and before January 1,
18	2028, the payment amount under this section for such
19	test shall be equal to \$200.
20	"(2) HCPCS code and modifier assign-
21	MENT.—
22	"(A) In general.—The Secretary shall as-
23	sign one or more HCPCS codes to the DNA
24	Specimen Provenance Assay clinical diagnostic
25	laboratory test and may use a modifier to facili-

tate making payment under this section with re spect to such test.

"(B) IDENTIFICATION OF DNA MATCH ON CLAIM.—The Secretary shall require an indication on a claim for a DNA Specimen Provenance Assay clinical diagnostic laboratory test of whether the DNA of the prostate biopsy specimen for such test matches the DNA of the individual with respect to whom the test was ordered. Such indication may be made through use of a HCPCS code, a modifier, or other means, as determined appropriate by the Secretary.

"(3) DNA MATCH REVIEW.—

"(A) In General.—The Secretary shall review at least three years of claims under part B for DNA Specimen Provenance Assay clinical diagnostic laboratory tests to identify whether the DNA of the prostate biopsy specimens for such tests matched the DNA of the individuals with respect to whom such tests were ordered.

"(B) Posting on internet website.—Not later than July 1, 2024, the Secretary shall post on the Internet website of the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services the findings of the review conducted under subparagraph (A).

2	$graph \ (1) \ and \ section \ 1862(a)(1)(Q), \ the \ date \ speci-$
3	fied in this paragraph is the first day of the second
4	calendar quarter that begins at least 180 days after
5	the date of the enactment of this subsection.".
