A BILL

To repeal COVID-19 vaccination requirements imposed by the District of Columbia.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Restore Parental and
- 5 Consumer Medical Rights in the Nation's Capital Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF DC VACCINE MANDATES.
- 7 The following shall have no force or effect:
- 8 (1) Order 2021–148 issued by the Mayor of the
- 9 District of Columbia on December 22, 2021.
