BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – State Government Section 9-1E-17(d)Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Government 9-1E-17.A sports wagering licensee or sports wagering operator that advertises in the State [may] SHALL contract with an independent evaluator licensed under subsection (b) of this section to evaluate and rate the sports wagering licensee's sports wagering content, sports wagering experts, sports wagering influencers, and content partners.
