3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.					
4	This Act may be cited as the "Furthering Access to					
5	Stroke Telemedicine Act of 2017" or the "FAST Act of					
6	2017".					
7	SEC. 2. EXPANDING ACCESS TO TELEHEALTH-ELIGIBLE					
8	STROKE SERVICES UNDER THE MEDICARE					
9	PROGRAM.					
10	(a) In General.—Section 1834(m)(4) of the Social					
11	Security Act (42 U.S.C. $1395m(m)(4)$ ) is amended—					
12	(1) in subparagraph (C)—					
13	(A) in clause (i), in the matter preceding					
14	subclause (I), by striking "The term" and insert-					
15	ing "Except as provided in clause (iii), the					
16	term"; and					
17	(B) by adding at the end the following new					
18	clause:					
19	"(iii) Telehealth-eligible stroke					
20	SERVICES.—With respect to telehealth-eligi-					
21	ble stroke services, the term 'originating					
22	site' means any hospital (as defined in sec-					
23	tion 1861(e)) or critical access hospital (as					
24	defined in section $1861(mm)(1)$ , or any					
25	mobile stroke unit, at which the eligible tele-					

1	health individual is located at the time the					
2	service is furnished via a telecommuni-					
3	cations system, regardless of where the hos-					
4	pital, critical access hospital, or mobile					
5	stroke unit is located.";					
6	(2) in subparagraph $(F)(i)$ by inserting "tele-					
7	health-eligible stroke services," after "Secretary)),";					
8	and					
9	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-					
10	paragraph:					
11	"(G) Telehealth-eligible stroke serv-					
12	ICES.—The term 'telehealth-eligible stroke serv-					
13	ices' means services that are—					
14	"(i) related to the diagnosis, evalua-					
15	tion, or treatment of symptoms of an acute					
16	stroke in an individual; and					
17	"(ii) furnished to such individual not					
18	later than four and a half hours (or such					
19	other clinically appropriate amount of time					
20	as is determined by the Secretary) after the					
21	onset of such symptoms with respect to such					
22	individual.".					
23	(b) No Originating Site Facility Fee for New					
24	SITES.—Section 1834(m)(2)(B) of the Social Security Act					
25	$(42\ U.S.C.\ 1395m(m)(2)(B))$ is amended—					

1	(1) by redesignating clauses (i) and (ii) as sub-					
2	clauses (I) and (II), respectively (and adjusting the					
3	margins accordingly);					
4	(2) in subclause (II), as redesignated by para-					
5	graph (1), by striking "clause (i) or this clause" and					
6	inserting "subclause (I) or this subclause";					
7	(3) by striking "SITE.—With respect to" and in-					
8	serting "SITE.—					
9	"(i) In general.—With respect to";					
10	(4) by striking "subject to section 1833(a)(1)(U)"					
11	and inserting "subject to clause (ii) and section					
12	1833(a)(1)(U)"; and					
13	(5) by adding at the end the following new					
14	clause:					
15	"(ii) No originating site facility					
16	FEE FOR CERTAIN TELESTROKE SERV-					
17	ICES.—No facility fee shall be paid under					
18	this subparagraph to an originating site					
19	that is described in clause (iii) of para-					
20	graph (4)(C) and that would not otherwise					
21	meet the requirements for an originating					
22	site under paragraph (4)(C) without appli-					
23	cation of the amendments made by the					
24	FAST Act of 2017.".
