- 6 Postal Service located at 1900 Corporate Drive in Bir-
- 7 mingham, Alabama, shall be known and designated as the

- 1 "Lance Corporal Thomas E. Rivers, Jr. Post Office Build-
- 2 ing".
- 3 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 6 be deemed to be a reference to the "Lance Corporal Thom-
- 7 as E. Rivers, Jr. Post Office Building".
