

SENATE BILL 2427

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57,
Chapter 3 and Title 57, Chapter 5, relative to
entities authorized to sell intoxicating beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-404(e)(4), is amended by
adding the following new subdivision:

() Notwithstanding another law to the contrary, any hemp-based product for
which all required licenses, permits, or certificates have been obtained authorizing the
sale of such product within this state.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-404(e), is amended by adding
the following new subdivision:

() This chapter does not authorize a retail package store to charge any money
or fee, directly or indirectly, for the provision of alcoholic beverages or beer for
consumption on the premises, including, but not limited to, the charging of a fee for a
class or other service that may include the provision of alcoholic beverages or beer for
consumption on the premises.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-406(j)(1), is amended by
deleting the subdivision and substituting:

(1) Notwithstanding this title to the contrary, retailers licensed under § 57-3-204
may supply, sell, deliver, and install products authorized to be sold by the retailer to
locations outside of the licensed premises.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 5, Part 1, is amended by
adding the following as a new section:

Notwithstanding another law to the contrary, an entity that holds a beer permit issued under this chapter may sell at retail any hemp-based product for which all required licenses, permits, or certificates have been obtained authorizing the sale of such product within this state.

SECTION 5. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
