JUDGES: Creates an additional judgeship for the 21st Judicial District Court

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AN ACT

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To amend and reenact R.S. 13:621.21, relative to the Twenty-First Judicial District Court;

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to create an additional judgeship for the Twenty-First Judicial District Court; and to

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provide for related matters.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

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Section 1. R.S. 13:621.21 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

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§621.21. Twenty-First Judicial District

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A. The Twenty-First Judicial District Court shall have ~~nine~~ ten judges.
