A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to recover the cost of processing administrative protests for oil and gas lease sales, applications for permits to drill, and right of way applications, and for other purposes.

3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.				
4	This Act may be cited as the "Removing Barriers				
5	Energy Independence Act".				
6	SEC. 2. ADMINISTRATIVE PROTEST PROCESS REFORM.				
7	Section 17 of the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 226)				
8	3 is amended by adding at the end the following:				
9	"(q) Protest Filing Fee.—				
10	"(1) In general.—Before processing any pro-				
11	1 test filed under this section, the Secretary shall coll				
12	2 a filing fee from the protestor to recover the cost f				
13	processing documents filed for each administration				
14	protest.				
15	"(2) Amount.—The filing fee shall be calculated				
16	as follows:				
17	"(A) For each protest filed in a submission				
18	not exceeding 10 pages in length, the base filing				
19	fee shall be \$150.				
20	"(B) For each submission exceeding 10				
21	pages in length, an addition to the base filing				
22	fee, an assessment of \$5 per page in excess of 10				
23	pages shall apply.				
24	"(C) For protests that include more than				
25	one oil and aas lease parcel right-of-way or ap-				

plication for permit to drill in a submission, an additional assessment of \$10 per additional lease parcel, right-of-way, or application for permit to drill shall apply.

"(3) Adjustment.—

"(A) In General.—Beginning on January 1, 2020, and annually thereafter, the Secretary shall adjust the filing fees established in this subsection to whole dollar amounts to reflect changes in the Producer Price Index, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, for the previous 12 months.

"(B) Publication of adjusted filing fees as adjusted under this paragraph take effect, the Secretary shall publish notification of the adjustment of such fees in the Federal Register.".
