A BILL

To require the imposition of sanctions against Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "IRGC Terrorist Sanc-
- 5 tions Act of 2017".
- 6 SEC. 2. SANCTIONS AND REPORT BY PRESIDENT.
- 7 (a) Sanctions.—The President shall, not later than
- 8 30 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, des-
- 9 ignate Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps as a ter-
- 10 rorist entity under section 1(b) of Executive Order 13224

- 1 of September 24, 2001, and impose sanctions against
- 2 Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps under section
- 3 1(b) of Executive Order 13224 of September 24, 2001,
- 4 or under any other provision of law, as applicable.
- 5 (b) Report.—
- 6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President shall submit 7 to Congress a report that contains the results of the
- 8 imposition of sanctions under subsection (a).
- 9 (2) FORM.—The report under paragraph (1) 10 should be submitted in unclassified form, but may 11 contain a classified annex.
