## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Adult Protective Services - Review Boards - Membership and Terms 3 FOR the purpose of altering provisions relating to the membership of, and the terms of 4 members appointed to, adult public guardianship review boards; and generally relating to adult protective services. 5 6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 7 Article – Family Law 8 Section 14-402 Annotated Code of Maryland 9 (2019 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 12 13 Article - Family Law 14 14–402. 15 Each review board consists of [11] 8 members RECRUITED AND (a) (1) 16 appointed: 17 (i) by the county commissioners; 18 in Baltimore City, by the Mayor with the advice and consent of (ii) 19 the City Council;



1 2	(iii) in any county that has a county executive, by the county executive with the advice and consent of the county council; or
3 4	(iv) if 2 or more counties have agreed to establish a multicounty review board, jointly by the appropriate officials of the counties served by the board.
5	(2) Of the [11] 8 members:
6	(i) 1 shall be a professional representative of a local department;
7 8	[(ii) 1. in counties other than St. Mary's County or Washington County:
9 10	A.] (II) 1 shall be a physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, REGISTERED NURSE, or physician who is not a psychiatrist; [and]
11 12 13	[B.] (III) 1 shall be a psychiatrist, A PSYCHIATRIC NURSE PRACTITIONER, OR A PROFESSIONAL WITH EXPERTISE IN PRESCRIBING OR OVERSIGHT OF MENTAL HEALTH MEDICATIONS; [and
14	2. in St. Mary's County and Washington County:
15 16	A. 1 shall be a physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, or physician who is not a psychiatrist; and
17	B. 1 shall be a psychiatrist or psychologist;
18	(iii)] (IV) 1 shall be a representative of a local commission on aging;
19 20	[(iv)] (V) 1 shall be a professional representative of a local nonprofit social service organization;
21	[(v)] (VI) 1 shall be a lawyer;
22	[(vi)] (VII) [2] 1 shall be A lay [individuals] INDIVIDUAL; AND
23	[(vii) 1 shall be a registered nurse;]
24 25	(viii) 1 shall be a professional in the field of disabilities[; and] OR A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY.
26	[(ix) 1 shall be a person with a physical disability.]
27 28	(b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph [(3)] (2) of this subsection, the term of a member is 3 years.

- 1 **[**(2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided 2 for members of the review board on October 1, 1984.
- 3 (3)] (2) In Charles County, the term of a member is 4 years.
- [(4)] (3) At the end of a term, a member [continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies] MAY SERVE FOR ANOTHER TERM ON 6 APPOINTMENT.
- 7 **[**(5)**] (4)** A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only 8 for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2024.
