Officer Traylor provided aid and cover for the officers around

him during a stand-off that lasted several hours and included

state and local officers from multiple jurisdictions; the

situation ended when the gunman took his own life; and

WHEREAS, placed in a life-threatening situation and without a moment's hesitation, Officer Thomas C. Traylor placed himself in the line of peril and stopped the individual from inflicting further harm or death and ended an eminent threat to civilians in the immediate area; and

WHEREAS, Officer Thomas C. Traylor demonstrated immense courage, diligence, and quick response in a life-threatening situation; his loyalty and unwavering commitment to protect and serve the residents of Randolph County were evidenced through his willingness to make the quick and proper response in order to protect the lives of others; and

WHEREAS, Officer Thomas C. Traylor epitomizes the qualities of those who serve and protect, and he is truly deserving of this distinguished nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore,
