A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Massage Therapy – Continuing Education Requirements**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Massage Therapy Examiners to establish
4 certain continuing education requirements; authorizing the Board to refuse to renew
5 the license of a licensed massage therapist who fails to attend the required course or
6 submit certification of attendance at the required courses; and generally relating to
7 continuing education requirements for licensed massage therapists.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Health Occupations**

21 6–101.

22 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

23 (b) “Board” means the State Board of Massage Therapy Examiners.

(d) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice massage therapy.

(e) "Licensed massage therapist" means an individual who is licensed by the Board to practice massage therapy.

(i) "Supervised hands-on techniques" means massage techniques that are performed under the direct, in-person supervision of a qualified licensed instructor who is on-site in:

(1) A classroom;

(2) A laboratory;

(3) A school clinic; or

(4) A health care setting.

(A) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS AS A CONDITION OF THE RENEWAL OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS TITLE.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO:

(1) APPROVE CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(2) ESTABLISH THE NUMBER OF HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIRED, AT LEAST HALF OF WHICH MUST INCLUDE SUPERVISED HANDS-ON TECHNIQUES.

(C) AT THE TIME A LICENSEE APPLIES FOR LICENSE RENEWAL, THE APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD, ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE BOARD, A CERTIFICATION THAT THE APPLICANT HAS ATTENDED THE REQUIRED COURSES.

(D) THE BOARD MAY REFUSE TO RENEW THE LICENSE OF A LICENSED MASSAGE THERAPIST WHO HAS:

(1) FAILED TO ATTEND THE REQUIRED COURSES; OR

(2) FAILED TO SUBMIT CERTIFICATION OF ATTENDANCE AT THE REQUIRED COURSES.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
2 1, 2026.
