## Public Service Commission - Out-of-State Carbon Pollution Program - Study

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Public Service Commission to study and make recommendations about establishing a program to address carbon pollution 4 5 attributed to electricity generated out-of-state but consumed within the State; 6 requiring the Commission to study and make recommendations regarding 7 establishing the program; requiring that the Commission solicit input from certain 8 entities and organizations; requiring the Commission to report its findings and 9 recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally relating to out-of-state carbon pollution. 10
