A BILL

To prohibit the sharing of United States intelligence with countries that permit operation of Huawei fifth generation telecommunications technology within their borders.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON SHARING OF UNITED STATES 4 INTELLIGENCE WITH COUNTRIES THAT PER-5 MIT OPERATION OF HUAWEI FIFTH GENERA-6 TION TELECOMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY 7 WITHIN THEIR BORDERS. 8 (a) Prohibition.—Intelligence of or under the control of the United States, including intelligence products

- 1 of the intelligence community, may not be shared with any
- 2 country that permits operation within its national borders
- 3 of fifth generation (5G) telecommunications technology of
- 4 Huawei Technologies Co. Ltd.
- 5 (b) Definitions.—In this section, the terms "intel-
- 6 ligence" and "intelligence community" have the meaning
- 7 given such terms in section 3 of the National Security Act
- 8 of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003).
