

- 1 (iii) If the boundary line of a district is changed, the term of an 2 incumbent member of the county board who no longer resides in the district because of the 3 change is not affected during this term.

  4 (4) (i) A member may not be elected or appointed to serve on the county board for more than three consecutive terms.
- 6 (ii) A member who has served three consecutive 4—year terms may 7 not be elected or appointed to the county board until at least 4 years have elapsed since the 8 end of the member's last term on the county board.
