A BILL

To provide clarification with respect to the effective date of Medicare coverage of COVID-19 vaccines without any cost-sharing.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Ensuring Access to
- 5 COVID-19 Vaccines for Seniors Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE OF MEDICARE COVERAGE OF
- 7 COVID-19 VACCINES WITHOUT ANY COST-
- 8 SHARING.
- 9 Effective as if included in the enactment of the
- 10 CARES Act (Public Law 116–136; 42 U.S.C. 13951

- 1 note), section 3713(d) of such Act is amended by inserting
- 2 before the period at the end the following: "or authorized
- 3 for emergency use under section 564 of the Federal Food,

4 Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 360bbb-3)".
