A BILL

To prohibit any hiring freeze from affecting the Environmental Protection Agency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON HIRING FREEZE FROM AF
FECTING ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

AGENCY.

The memorandum titled "Presidential Memorandum Regarding the Hiring Freeze" published on January 23,

2017, or any other substantially similar memorandum,

Executive order, or other action by the President to pre-

- 1 vent a department or agency of the Federal Government
- 2 from filling vacant Federal civilian employee positions or
- 3 creating new such positions, shall have no force or effect
- 4 with respect to positions within the Environmental Protec-

5 tion Agency.
