- 3 SECTION 1. REVIVAL OF VIRGIN ISLANDS OF THE UNITED
- 4 STATES CENTENNIAL COMMISSION.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Virgin Islands of the United
- 6 States Centennial Commission Act (Public Law 114–224)
- 7 is amended—
- 8 (1) in section 7(b)—
