A BILL

- To prohibit the Secretary of Health and Human Services from using any type of fee collected to advertise or market Exchanges established under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stop Obamacare Spam
 - 5 Act of 2017".

SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF USE OF FEES TO ADVERTISE OR

- 2 MARKET EXCHANGES UNDER PPACA.
- 3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on and
- 4 after the date of the enactment of this Act the Secretary
- 5 of Health and Human Services may not use any fees col-
- 6 lected, including assessments and fees charged under sec-
- 7 tion 1311(d)(5)(A) of the Patient Protection and Afford-
- 8 able Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18031(d)(5)(A)), to advertise
- 9 or otherwise market Exchanges established under such
- 10 Act, including advertising or marketing qualified health
- 11 plans offered through such Exchanges.
