A BILL

To permanently reauthorize the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT REAUTHORIZATION OF LAND AND 4 WATER CONSERVATION FUND. 5 (a) In General.—Section 200302 of title 54, United States Code, is amended— 7 (1) in subsection (b), in the matter preceding 8 paragraph (1), by striking "During the period ending September 30, 2018, there" and inserting 9

- 3 (b) Public Access.—Section 200306 of title 54,
- 4 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the

- 6 "(c) Public Access.—Not less than 1.5 percent of
- 7 amounts made available for expenditure in any fiscal year
- 8 under section 200303, or \$10,000,000, whichever is great-
- 9 er, shall be used for projects that secure recreational pub-
- 10 lic access to existing Federal public land for hunting, fish-
- 11 ing, and other recreational purposes.".
