JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia of certain defense articles.

- 3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
- 4 Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is prohibited:
- 5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles,
- 6 described in Transmittal No. 20–11, submitted to
- 7 Congress pursuant to section 36(b) of the Arms Ex-
- 8 port Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)) and published
- 9 in the Congressional Record on November 15, 2021:

Two hundred eighty (280) AIM-120C-7/C-8 Ad-1 2 vanced Medium Range Air-to-Air Missiles 3 (AMRAAM); five hundred ninety-six (596) LAU-4 128 Missile Rail Launchers (MRL); containers; 5 weapon support and support equipment; spare and 6 repair parts; United States Government and contractor engineering, technical, and logistical support 7 8 services; and other related elements of logistical and 9 program support.
