A BILL

To establish a minimum staffing level of U.S. Customs and Border Protection officers along the northern border, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLES.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Border Officers Utili-
- 5 zation for National Defense Act of 2019" or the "BOUND
- 6 Act".

SEC. 2. MINIMUM U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION

- 2 STAFFING ALONG THE NORTHERN BORDER.
- 3 (a) In General.—Beginning on the date of the en-
- 4 actment of this Act, the Commissioner of U.S. Customs
- 5 and Border Protection shall ensure that not fewer than
- 6 the maximum number of U.S. Customs and Border Pro-
- 7 tection officers deployed along the international border be-
- 8 tween the United States and Canada (referred to in this
- 9 Act as the "northern border") at any time between Janu-
- 10 ary 1, 2016 and the date of the enactment of this Act
- 11 are always deployed along the northern border, including
- 12 ports of entry along the northern border.
- 13 (b) Limitation on Transfers.—The Commissioner
- 14 of U.S. Customs and Border Protection may not transfer
- 15 any U.S. Customs and Border Protection officer away
- 16 from an assignment along the northern border if such
- 17 transfer would reduce the number of such officers as-
- 18 signed to the northern border below the level required
- 19 under subsection (a).
