A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. BENJAMIN A. GILMAN POST OFFICE BUILDING.
- 4 (a) Designation.—The facility of the United States
- 5 Postal Service located at 40 Fulton Street in Middletown,
- 6 New York, shall be known and designated as the "Ben-
- 7 jamin A. Gilman Post Office Building".

- 1 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 4 be deemed to be a reference to the "Benjamin A. Gilman

5 Post Office Building".
