A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class C (Theater) Beer, Wine, and**
3 **Liquor License**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class C (theater) beer, wine, and liquor license in
5 Frederick County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Frederick
6 County to issue the license; authorizing the license holder to sell beer, wine, and
7 liquor for on–premises consumption, subject to certain limitations; and generally
8 relating to alcoholic beverages in Frederick County.

25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
26 That Section(s) 20–1014.1 of Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis of the Annotated

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis

20–102.

This title applies only in Frederick County.

20–1014.1.

(A) THERE IS A CLASS C (THEATER) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

(B) THE MANAGER OF THE THEATER OR ANY OTHER OFFICIAL DESIGNATED BY THE THEATER MAY SIGN THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE.

(C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A LICENSE FOR USE BY A THEATER WITH SEATING.

(D) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION FROM 1 HOUR BEFORE TO 1 HOUR AFTER:

(1) A REGULAR PERFORMANCE;

(2) A FUND–RAISER PERFORMANCE THAT BENEFITS THE THEATER;

OR

(3) AN EVENT HOSTED BY AN OUTSIDE GROUP THAT HAS RENTED THE THEATER.

(E) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$150.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2025.
