3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.				
4	This Act may be cited as the "Ensuring Small Scale				
5	LNG Certainty and Access Act".				
6	SEC. 2. SMALL SCALE EXPORTATION OR IMPORTATION OF				
7	NATURAL GAS.				
8	Section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.				
9	717b(c)) is amended—				
10	(1) by striking "For purposes" and inserting				
11	"(1) For purposes"; and				
12	(2) by adding at the end the following:				
13	"(2) For purposes of subsection (a), and in addition				
14	to any importation or exportation of natural gas described				
15	in paragraph (1), importation or exportation of natura				
16	gas shall be deemed to be consistent with the public interest				
17	and an application for such importation or exportation				
18	shall be granted without modification or delay, if—				
19	"(A) the application for such importation or ex-				
20	portation proposes to import or export a volume of				
21	natural gas that does not exceed 0.14 billion cubic fe				
22	per day; and				
23	"(B) the Commission's approval of such applica-				
24	tion does not require an environmental impact state-
