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Environment - Lead and Mercury Wheel Weights - Prohibited

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from using, allowing to be used, or selling 4 certain lead or mercury wheel weights after certain dates; requiring the State to 5 ensure that no vehicle in the State fleet is equipped with certain lead or mercury wheel weights after a certain date; requiring lead and mercury wheel weights 6 7 removed and collected to be properly recycled; providing for the enforcement of this 8 Act, including the required issuance of a warning for an initial violation; and 9 generally relating to the prohibition against the use or sale of lead or mercury wheel 10 weights in the State.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 6-501.21
- **(1)** 22 (A) A MOTOR VEHICLE OR TIRE MANUFACTURER, WHOLESALER, OR
- 23 RETAILER, MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR FACILITY, OR ANY OTHER PERSON WHO

- 1 INSTALLS WHEEL WEIGHTS MAY NOT USE, ALLOW TO BE USED, OR SELL AN
- 2 EXTERNALLY ATTACHED LEAD WHEEL WEIGHT THAT IS COMPOSED OF GREATER
- 3 THAN 0.1% LEAD BY WEIGHT OR GREATER THAN 0.1% MERCURY BY WEIGHT DURING
- 4 THE FIRST TIRE INSTALLATION, REPLACEMENT, OR BALANCING AFTER:
- 5 (I) JANUARY 1, 2019, FOR ALL USED VEHICLES REGISTERED IN
- 6 THE STATE; AND
- 7 (II) JANUARY 1, 2020, FOR ALL NEW VEHICLES REGISTERED IN
- 8 THE STATE.
- 9 (2) THE STATE SHALL ENSURE THAT NO VEHICLE IN THE STATE
- 10 FLEET IS EQUIPPED WITH AN EXTERNALLY ATTACHED LEAD WHEEL WEIGHT THAT
- 11 IS COMPOSED OF GREATER THAN 0.1% LEAD BY WEIGHT OR GREATER THAN 0.1%
- 12 MERCURY BY WEIGHT AFTER JANUARY 1, 2019.
- 13 (B) LEAD AND MERCURY WHEEL WEIGHTS REMOVED AND COLLECTED
- 14 SHALL BE PROPERLY RECYCLED.
- 15 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SEND A WARNING NOTICE TO A PERSON
- 16 THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION.
- 17 (2) IF THE PERSON CONTINUES TO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THIS
- 18 SECTION 1 YEAR AFTER RECEIPT OF THE WARNING NOTICE, THE PERSON IS SUBJECT
- 19 TO A CIVIL FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE AFTER
- 20 THE WARNING PERIOD.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 2017.
