- 4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that not more than three members of the 5 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission from each county be 6 members of the same political party; requiring the County Council of Montgomery 7 County and the County Executive of Prince George's County to consider certain 8 diversity needs when making appointments for membership on the Commission; 9 establishing that the party composition of county commissioners from each county 10 shall be based on the election results for the County Executive in the last preceding 11 election: and generally relating to the membership Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission. 12

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 Article – Land Use

- 2 There is a Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission. (a)
- 3 (b) The Commission is a body politic and corporate and is an agency of the State.
- 4 15-102.
- The Commission consists of 10 members. 5 (a) (1)
- Of the 10 members of the Commission: 6 (2)
- 7 (i) five shall be residents and registered voters of Montgomery 8
- County; and
- 9 five shall be residents and registered voters of Prince George's (ii)
- County. 10
- 11 (3)Subject to the approval of the County Executive, the County
- Council shall appoint each commissioner from Montgomery County. 12
- 13 Subject to the approval of the County Council, the County (ii)
- 14 Executive shall appoint each commissioner from Prince George's County.
- 15 (b) Each commissioner shall be an individual of ability, experience, and integrity.
- 16 Of the commissioners from each county, not more than three shall be (1)
- members of the same political party] WHEN MAKING AN APPOINTMENT FOR 17
- MEMBERSHIP ON THE COMMISSION, THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF MONTGOMERY 18
- COUNTY AND, SUBJECT TO § 15–103(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE 19
- OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL CONSIDER THE NEED FOR GEOGRAPHIC, 20
- POLITICAL, RACIAL, ETHNIC, AND GENDER DIVERSITY AND FOR THE INCLUSION OF 21
- 22INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES ON THE COMMISSION.
- 23**(2)** OF THE COMMISSIONERS FROM EACH COUNTY:
- IF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE RECEIVED LESS THAN 80% OF 24 **(I)**
- 25 THE VOTES CAST AT THE LAST PRECEDING GENERAL ELECTION, NOT MORE THAN
- 26 THREE COMMISSIONERS MAY BE OF THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY AS THE COUNTY
- 27 **EXECUTIVE**; OR
- 28 IF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE RECEIVED AT LEAST 80% OF (II)
- 29 THE VOTES CAST AT THE LAST PRECEDING GENERAL ELECTION, NOT MORE THAN
- FOUR COMMISSIONERS MAY BE OF THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY AS THE COUNTY 30
- EXECUTIVE. 31

- 1 **[**(2)**] (3)** A commissioner may not be selected as representing or 2 supporting any special interest.
- 3 (d) (1) The term of a commissioner is 4 years and begins on June 15.
- 4 (2) The terms of commissioners are staggered as required by the terms 5 provided for commissioners on October 1, 2012.
- 6 (3) At the end of a term, a commissioner continues to serve until a successor 7 is appointed and qualifies.
- 8 (4) A commissioner who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 9 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 10 (5) A commissioner who is appointed to fill a vacancy for an unexpired term shall be a member of the same political party as the commissioner who vacated the office.
- 12 (6) (i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a commissioner appointed from Montgomery County may not be appointed for three consecutive full terms.
- 15 (ii) A commissioner appointed from Montgomery County may be 16 appointed for a maximum of three consecutive full terms as a member of the Commission 17 if the commissioner is designated as chair of the Montgomery County Planning Board 18 during the commissioner's second term in office.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 2023.
