AN ACT concerning
National Capital Strategic Economic Development Program – Eligibility \underline{and} $\underline{Funding}$
FOR the purpose of <u>extending certain funding to each fiscal year</u> ; altering the definition of "national capital region" for the purposes of the National Capital Strategic Economic Development Program; requiring certain percentages of the National Capital Strategic Economic Development Fund to be used for community enhancement projects in sustainable communities located in certain areas in certain fiscal years; and generally relating to the National Capital Strategic Economic Development Program.
BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Housing and Community Development Section 6–701 and 6–710
