## A BILL

To amend the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 to provide families year-round access to nutrition incentives under the Gus Schumacher Nutrition Incentive Program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Supporting all Healthy
- 5 Options when Purchasing Produce Act of 2025" or the
- 6 "SHOPP Act of 2025".

### SEC. 2. NUTRITION INCENTIVES UNDER GUS SCHUMACHER 2 NUTRITION INCENTIVE PROGRAM. 3 Section 4405 of the Food, Conservation, and Energy 4 Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 7517) is amended— 5 (1) in subsection (b)(2)(B)— 6 (A) by redesignating clauses (ix) and (x) 7 as clauses (x) and (xi), respectively; and 8 (B) by inserting after clause (viii) the fol-9 lowing: "(ix) increase the year-round avail-10 ability of the incentive described in sub-11 12 paragraph (A)(ii)(II) by offering fresh fro-13 zen fruits or vegetables;"; and 14 (2) in subsection (c)— 15 (A) in paragraph (1)(A), by striking "fruits and vegetables" and inserting "fruits, 16 17 vegetables, and legumes"; and 18 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking "fresh fruits and vegetables" each place it appears and 19 20 inserting "fresh or fresh frozen fruits, vegeta-21 bles, and legumes".
