A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Department of Assessments and Taxation and Department of General**
3 **Services – Property Appraisal Aids – Geographic Images**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Assessments and Taxation to
5 prepare, install, and maintain certain property appraisal aids that consist of a
6 database of certain geographic images; requiring the Department of General
7 Services to procure for the State a certain uniform system that includes any tools or
8 services needed to prepare, maintain, and install the appraisal aids; and generally
9 relating to property appraisal aids and records.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Tax – Property**

19 (a) **(1)** The Department shall prepare, install, and maintain for each county a
20 complete record of properties, with appropriate indexes and cross indexes, and a system of
21 appraisal aids that consist of:

22 [(1)] **(I)** property location maps; [and]

23 [(2)] **(II)** records of:

5 (III) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
6 DATABASE OF STATEWIDE AND LOCAL GEOGRAPHIC IMAGES THAT INCLUDES:

7 1. GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM
8 VISUALIZATIONS; AND

9 2. OBLIQUE AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGERY.

10 (2) (I) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL
11 PROCURE FOR THE STATE A UNIFORM SYSTEM THAT INCLUDES ANY TOOLS OR
12 SERVICES NEEDED TO PREPARE, INSTALL, AND MAINTAIN THE APPRAISAL AIDS
13 DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

14 (II) TO CARRY OUT THE REQUIREMENT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH
15 (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SHALL:

16 1. GATHER INFORMATION AND INPUT ON THE
17 REQUIREMENTS OF THE APPRAISAL AIDS BY CONSULTING WITH THE DEPARTMENT
18 AND AFFECTED OR RELEVANT UNITS OF STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT; AND

19 2. IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE APPRAISAL AIDS,
20 DEVELOP AND MANAGE A COST-SHARING PLAN BETWEEN THE UNITS OF
21 GOVERNMENT THAT UTILIZE THE APPRAISAL AIDS.

22 (b) (1) The Department shall publish instructions and directions that set forth
23 generally the duties to be performed and the procedures to be followed in making and
24 recording assessments.

25 (2) The instructions and directions shall be distributed to the governing
26 body of each county, all assessment officers, and any official who has any duty that relates
27 to assessments.

28 (c) The Director shall establish and provide all forms for notices, records, reports,
29 and other matters that relate to the functions of supervisors and assessors.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June

1 1, 2024.
