A BILL

To prohibit military aid to Saudi Arabia until the Secretary of State determines that Jamal Khashoggi is alive and free.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RESTRICTION ON MILITARY AID TO SAUDI ARA-
- 4 BIA.
- 5 The United States Government shall not provide any
- 6 military aid or assistance to the Government of Saudi Ara-
- 7 bia until the Secretary of State certifies to Congress that
- 8 journalist Jamal Khashoggi is alive and free and subse-

- 1 quent legislation is enacted authorizing the resumption of
- 2 such aid and assistance.
