CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Miniature Golf Course License**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Frederick County
4 to issue a Class B–MGC (miniature golf course) license to a miniature golf course
5 under certain circumstances; authorizing a license holder to sell beer, wine, and
6 liquor for on–premises consumption under certain circumstances; requiring a license
7 holder to submit a certain report to the Board before a license may be renewed; and
8 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Frederick County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That Section(s) 20–1009.2 of Article – Alcoholic Beverages of the Annotated Code of
Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 20–1009.3.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read
as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages

20–102.

This title applies only in Frederick County.

20–1009.2.

(A) THERE IS A CLASS B–MGC (MINIATURE GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE,
AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

(B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR USE BY A MINIATURE GOLF
COURSE THAT:

(1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC;

(2) HAS A MINIATURE COURSE OF AT LEAST 18 HOLES; AND

(3) HAS ACCOMMODATIONS THAT ARE PREDOMINANTLY DEDICATED
TO MINIATURE GOLF.

(C) AN APPLICANT FOR A CLASS B–MGC (MINIATURE GOLF COURSE) BEER,
WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD A FLOOR PLAN OR
LAYOUT OF THE PROPOSED LICENSED PREMISES THAT ILLUSTRATES THAT THE
PROPOSED LICENSED PREMISES IS PREDOMINANTLY DEDICATED TO MINIATURE
GOLF.

(D) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FOR
ON–PREMISES CONSUMPTION:

(1) IF THE LICENSE HOLDER OFFERS FOOD ON–PREMISES AT ALL
TIMES WHEN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE BEING SOLD; AND

(2) DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH §
20–2005 OF THIS TITLE.

1 **(E) (1) THE LICENSE HOLDER’S ANNUAL SALES FROM:**

2 **(I) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY NOT EXCEED 35% OF THE**
3 **ANNUAL GROSS SALES OF THE MINIATURE GOLF COURSE;**

4 **(II) MINIATURE GOLF GAMES SHALL BE AT LEAST 50% OF THE**
5 **ANNUAL GROSS SALES OF THE MINIATURE GOLF COURSE; AND**

6 **(III) FOOD SHALL BE AT LEAST 15% OF THE ANNUAL GROSS**
7 **SALES OF THE MINIATURE GOLF COURSE.**

8 **(2) BEFORE THE BOARD MAY RENEW A CLASS B–MGC (MINIATURE**
9 **GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE, THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL**
10 **PROVIDE THE BOARD WITH AN ANNUAL GROSS SALES REPORT FOR ALCOHOL,**
11 **MINIATURE GOLF GAMES, AND FOOD THAT SHOWS THE LICENSE HOLDER HAS MET**
12 **THE REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.**

13 **(F) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,500.**

14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
15 1, 2023.
