BY adding to Article - Natural Resources Section 4-904 to be under the amended subtitle "Subtitle 9. Lobster, Shrimp, Terrapin, and Conch" Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Natural Resources** Subtitle 9. Lobster, SHRIMP, Terrapin, and Conch. 4-904.
