## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol to honor the last surviving Medal of Honor recipient of the Second World War upon death.

- 1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate

- 3 SECTION 1. HONORING LAST SURVIVING MEDAL OF HONOR
- 4 RECIPIENT OF SECOND WORLD WAR.
- 5 (a) USE OF ROTUNDA.—At the election of the indi-
- 6 vidual (or next of kin of the individual), the last individual
- 7 to die who was awarded the Medal of Honor for acts per-
- 8 formed during World War II shall be permitted to lie in
- 9 honor in the rotunda of the Capitol upon death.

- 1 (b) IMPLEMENTATION.—The Architect of the Capitol,
- 2 under the direction and supervision of the President pro
- 3 tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
- 4 Representatives, shall take the necessary steps to imple-
- 5 ment subsection (a) upon the death of the individual de-

6 scribed in such subsection.
