## Vehicle Laws - Driving in Right-Hand Lanes

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the driver of a vehicle traveling slower than the general speed 4 of traffic on certain highways to drive the vehicle in the right-hand lanes under 5 certain circumstances; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to include certain 6 information in the State's driver education curriculum; requiring the State Highway 7 Administration to inform drivers of certain requirements by posting certain signage 8 and providing certain notice in a certain manner; requiring the Motor Vehicle 9 Administration and the State Highway Administration to provide a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly; and generally relating to requirements 10 11 to drive in the right-hand lanes of a roadway.

(b) (1) On every roadway, except while overtaking and passing another vehicle going in the same direction or when preparing for a lawful left turn, any vehicle going 10 miles per hour or more below the applicable maximum speed limit or, if any existing conditions reasonably require a speed below that of the applicable maximum, at less than the normal speed of traffic under these conditions, shall be driven in the right—hand lane

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 1, 17
- 2022, the Motor Vehicle Administration and the State Highway Administration shall report 18
- 19 jointly to the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee and the House Environment and
- 20 Transportation Committee, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article,
- on the efforts made to provide driver education and notice throughout the State required 21
- 22under this Act.

- 24October 1, 2020.
